Please put items at the curb no earlier than 4 days prior to your scheduled pick up day. If you do not have your items on the curb by the time and day the pickup occurs you must remove your items from the tree lawn or you will be subject to violation. The trash hauler will NOT return to your ward after the designated pick up date. Items must be small enough to be handled by two people.

Accepted Items

- Items small enough to be handled by two people.
- Furniture, electronics, toys, bikes, carpet, mattresses etc.
- Appliances should be in a separate pile, remove doors.
- Scrap metal should be placed in pile with appliances.
- Building material will be collected in small amounts if it is contained for easy handling.

Prohibited Items

None of these items will be picked up

- Regular household garbage
- Tires, and batteries
- Large quantities of construction material
- Bricks, blocks, concrete or railroad ties
- Chemicals
- Liquid paint
- Asbestos containing material
